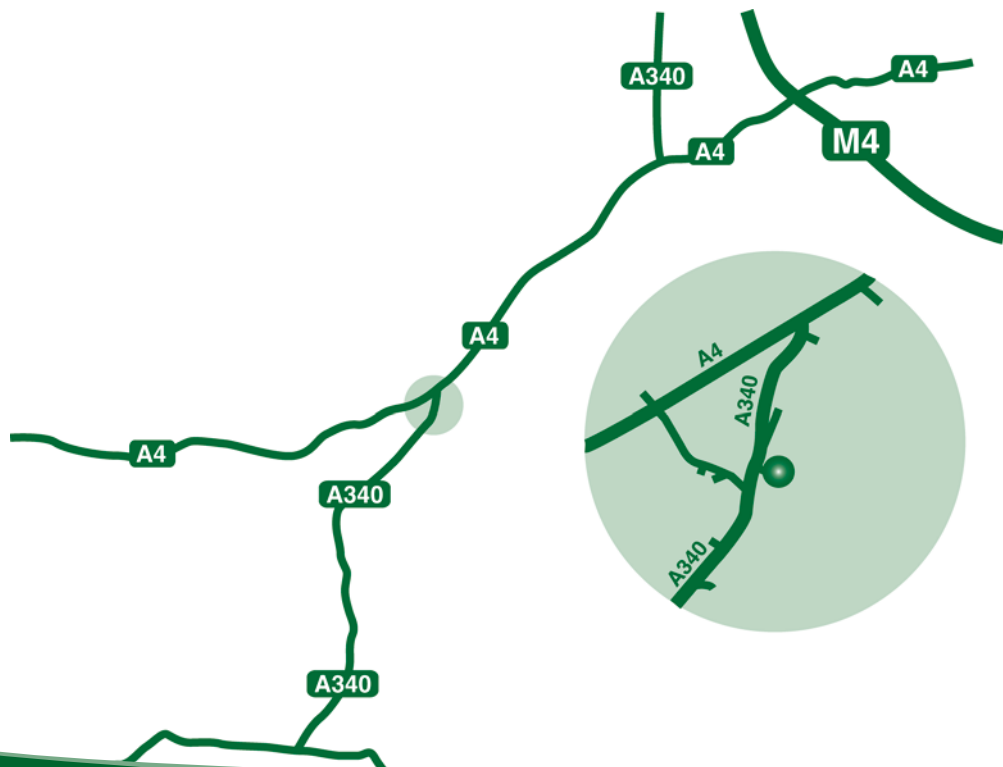
DIRECTIONS

BY ROAD:

- Leave the M4 at junction 12 and at the roundabout take the first exit onto the A4, Bath Road.
- At the next roundabout take the second exit following A4, Bath Road.
- Again at the next roundabout take the second exit following A4, Bath Road.
- At the next roundabout take the second exit following A340, Basingstoke Road.
- Take a left turn on Wharfside and the marina office is straight ahead.

BY RAIL: The nearest railway station is Aldermaston which is 300 metres away. For more information about train timetables and ticket costs please go to www.thetrainline.com

FROM AIRPORTS: London Heathrow airport is 40 miles away (45 minutes by car), and Gatwick, Luton and Stansted airports are all linked to Reading by motorway and bus services.

ALDERMASTON TO PEWSEY & RETURN (ONE WEEK)

Start: Aldermaston **Finish:** Aldermaston **Total Distance:** 62 miles

Starting from the small boating centre of Aldermaston Wharf, cruise west to the picturesque market town of Newbury. There are some nice pubs at the canalside village of Kintbury before arriving at Hungerford, stop off and visit the numerous antique shops and admire the charming canal scene.

Then it's on to Great Bedwyn and Crofton Pump Station, home to the world's oldest working beam engine. Don't miss the historic conservation village at Wootton Rivers on your way to the traditional village of Pewsey with its beautiful thatched cottages.

THAMES CRUISING

We are happy to allow our hire fleet to cruise on the River Thames but please note that boats are only licensed for British Waterways Canals. River Thames cruising will require an additional license at extra cost. When planning any river cruising within your route, do bear in mind that in some weather conditions river navigation may be restricted, so it is worth having an alternative plan.
